Brenda McBain reported that the Board of Governors met on December 2. The first order of business was the swearing in of Mike Stubbing, who replaces Cindy Choi and will chair the Finance Committee of the Board. The Board also approved revisions to the Executive Committee Terms of Reference to clarify that the Executive Committee is responsible for student appeals of suspensions and the decision of the Executive Committee of the Board is final.
