Sherri gifted the Board the Hearts and Hands pins and talked about the artist who made them, Carey Newman. Foundation has brought in over two million dollars in donations this year which has supported almost 1400 students. Giving Tuesday was successful with their goal of over \$30,000 being reached. The Board approved the cancellation of the Live Event and Audio-Visual Technician program. The Terms of Reference for the Governance Policy Review Committee were agreed.
