Course Description:

This is an introductory course in Modern Standard Chinese designed for students with no background in Chinese. The course objective is to provide a systematic introduction to modern Chinese in both its spoken and written forms. The important aspects of the course consist of the acquisition of a thorough grounding in pronunciation, the introduction of basic grammar and written characters. The textbook begins with the "Foundation Work" which is the most important part of the course, at the end of the "Foundation Work", the character workbook will be used and five characters will be learned each day. Classes will be so structured as to provide maximum opportunity for students' participation with the aim of acquiring both fluency and accuracy in the use of Mandarin Chinese.

Assignments:

Written and oral exercises will be assigned at the end of each lesson. All assignments are expected to be completed on time.

Tests and Examinations:

A quiz will be given every week. There will be a Mid-term Exam, an Oral Exam and a Final Exam. The specific date for each exam will be noticed in advance.
