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Course Description:

An introduction to contemporary Japanese society using social, economic, and political history, and emphasizing the political economy of modern Japan. It includes the adaptation of Western liberal, democratic, political structures; the impact of social change; the generation of the "economic miracle" post-WWII; and the evolving role of Japan internationally.

Hane, Mikiso. *Modern Japan: A Historical Survey*. Third Edition. Additional readings will be recommended during the course.
