# PNUR 142: HUMAN RELATIONSHIPS 2 (27 hours)

#### **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

This course focuses on effective interpersonal communication with the older adult. Age-related changes and health challenges that interfere with interpersonal communication will be examined and methods explored to overcome these challenges. Effective ways to work with groups of older adults will also be examined. The learner will also be introduced to leadership skills required for effective team functioning.

#### **LEARNING OUTCOMES**

At the completion of this course, the learner will be able to:

- 1. Adapt communications effectively with older adults experiencing health challenges that can interfere with interpersonal communications.
- 2. Interact with older adults in groups in ways that contribute to the effectiveness of the group
- 3. Use beginning leadership skills

#### CONTENT

## Communication with Aging Clients

- ⇒ exploring approaches to effective communication with older adults honoring the person's background, values, beliefs, and experiences
- ⇒ discussing approaches to effective communication with aging individuals who are suffering from sensory impairments
- ⇒ examining ways to communicate with adults experiencing dementia or other changes in mental functioning
- ⇒ discussing a variety of adaptive communication strategies

#### Therapeutic Group Work with Older Adults

- ⇒ examining different types of groups
- ⇒ exploring communication patterns in and developmental phases of groups
- ⇒ discussing the effects of environment on group interaction
- ⇒ exploring personal and leadership influences
- ⇒ examining special requirements of groups of older adults

#### Leadership

- ⇒ examining ways that the PN contributes to team functioning through creative and adaptive practice
- ⇒ exploring what is meant by leadership skills
- ⇒ reflecting on own strengths in relation to leadership
- ⇒ discussing the wise use of leadership skills in PN practice

You can begin this report after your week 3 class. In that way you can complete your info and have your paper completed by or before due date of week 9.

3%	Description of older adults, places, conditions

10%	Insights, feelings and beliefs, including considerations as they relate to, Standards of Practice, Code of Ethics and Nurse/Client Relationships.
5%	Conclusion, including goals for improving your communications.
