PNUR 134: PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE 3 (20 HOURS)

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course integrates the concepts from previous professional practice courses and introduces the learner to practice in the community (maternal/child & mental health). The role of the practical nurse as leader is emphasized in interactions with clients, families, groups and other healthcare providers.

PRE-REQUISITES: Successful completion of all Level 2 courses and Level 2 Consolidate Practice Experience.

CO REQUISITES: Professional Practice 3; Health Promotion 3; Variations in Health 3; Integrated Nursing Practice 3.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

Upon successful completion of this course the learner will be able to:

- 1. Compare and contrast how legislation, professional standards, code of ethics and practice expectations influences the continuum of care in community Mental Health.
- 2. Identify and explain professional self-regulation and the implication for individual responsibilities and accountability of the Practical Nurse in the continuum of care.
- 3. Explain and evaluate the influence of collaborative and inter-professional relationships on a quality practice environment.
- 4. Consider the roles of other healthcare providers in determining one's own professional and inter-professional roles.
- 5. Demonstrate the ability to access and assess current, relevant professional practice resources to prepare for nursing practice in the community setting.
- 6. Explain the professional and legal responsibility of respecting cultural safety, diversity and inclusivity in the community setting.
- 7. Apply and evaluate an ethical decision making process to ethical dilemmas in nursing practice of clients from across the lifespan in community settings.
- 8. Demonstrate self-reflection and reflective journal writing to enhance learning and nursing practice.
- **9.** Explain the importance of self care strategies for nurses
