

Consortium of Camosun College, Royal Roads University and the University of Victoria
Leadership Legacy Award

The Leadership Legacy Award program celebrates the successful partnership of three British Columbia educational institutions that formed a Consortium in 2004 dedicated to furthering leadership programs in the Province of BC. The partnership originated from an agreement with the BC Public Service Agency for the design and delivery of programs in leadership education for middle and senior management in government.

The Leadership Legacy Award program recognizes individuals who are currently enrolled in leadership programs and who have strengthened leadership development either through their academic achievement, contributions to the larger community or promotion of leadership in the workplace.

Eligibility

Individuals enrolled in post secondary leadership programs in any of the three Consortium institutions, Camosun College, Royal Roads University, or the University of Victoria.

Applications should be supported by a letter from at least one referee who can speak to the applicant's accomplishments.

Selection Criteria

Applicants will be judged on leadership contributions. Examples of leadership contributions include:

- an initiative that improves support for students with disabilities;
- the design and execution of a plan that directly connects the learning institution to the community on pressing issues, such as climate change; or
- the development of a program that succeeds in reducing conflict in the workplace.

Selection of the winning applicant will be based on the extent to which the contribution:

Is important

The contribution must have a major impact, i.e. cause an ongoing change in practice or learning.

Has an effect

The contribution must be evident, i.e. ideas must have been implemented.

Affects others

Contributions should be directed at other individuals or groups and cannot be focused on the applicant.

Has the potential to be scaled

Contributions should be flexible so that they can be applied on a larger or smaller scale.

Application Process

The deadline for applications is December 1, 2011. Applications should be submitted to:
